

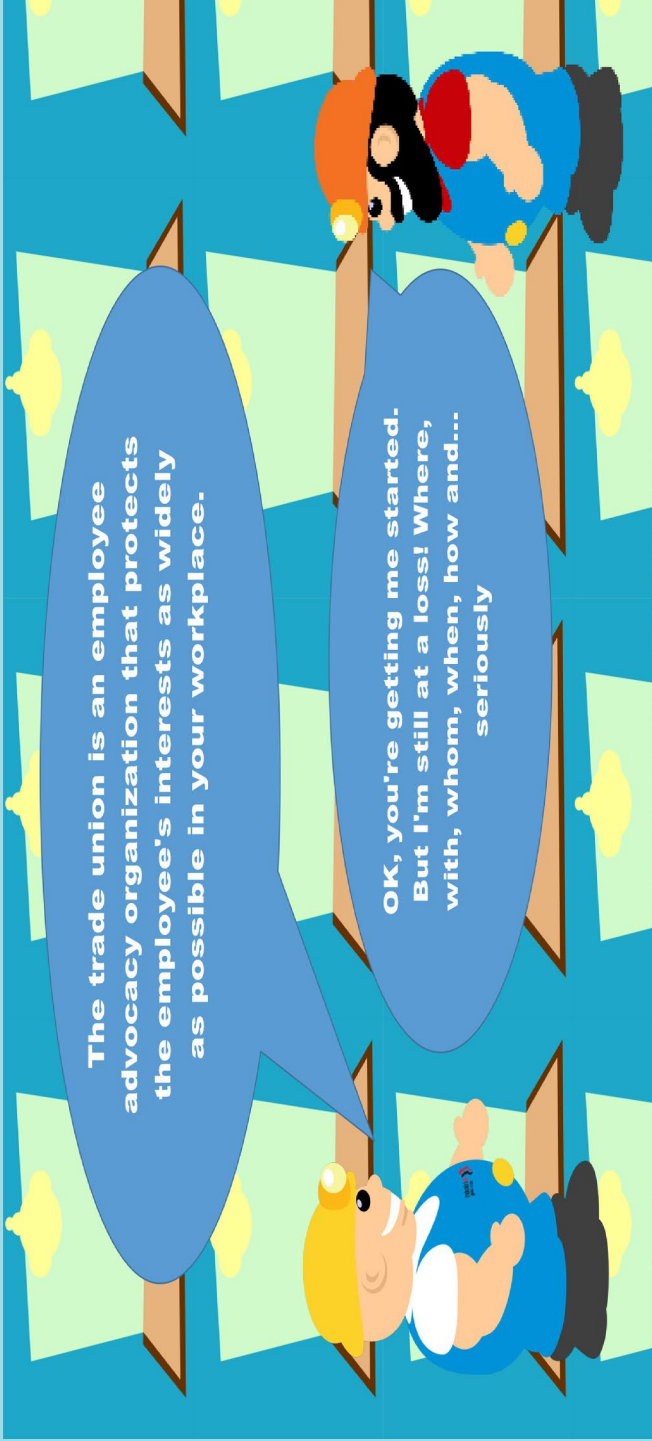
Kamusta

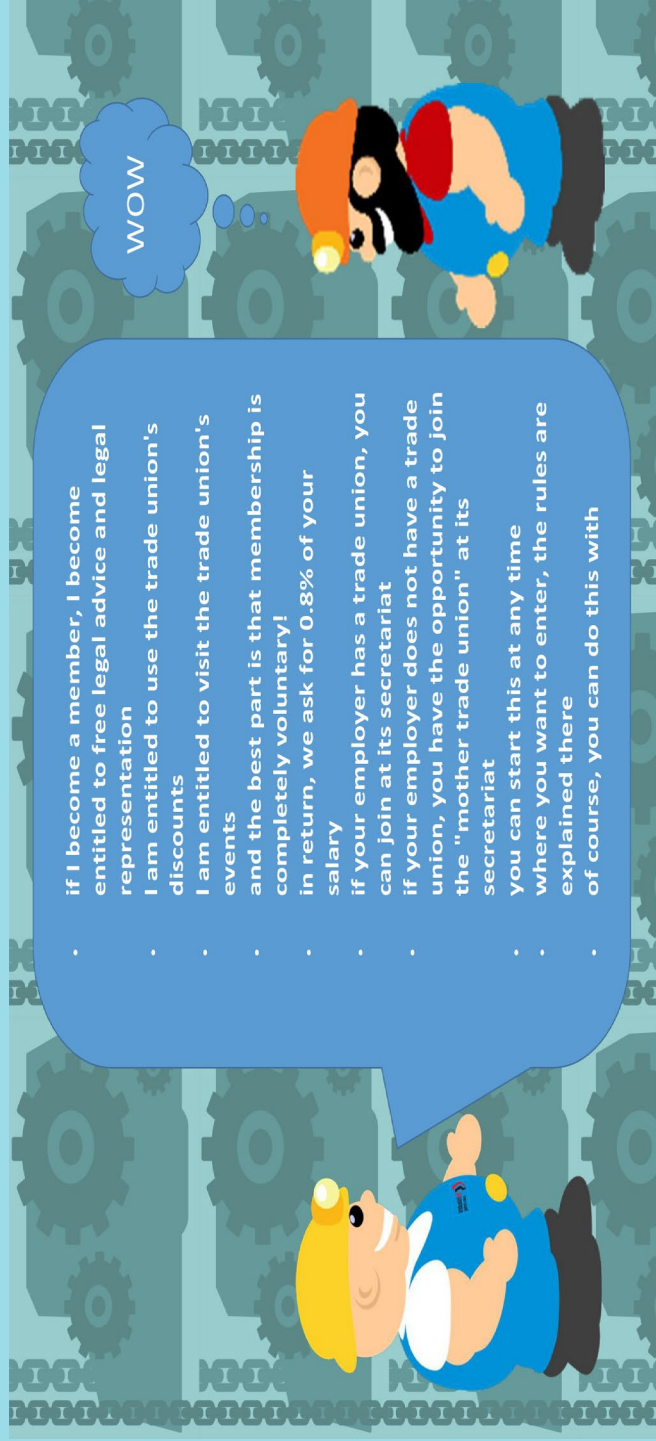
I will try to briefly and concisely describe the possibilities that can make working here easier.

Will I encounter language difficulties during the application process?

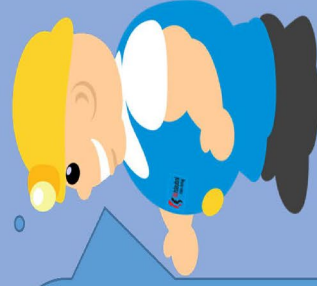
in principle no, we try to overcome this obstacle in every case (knowledge/use of a foreign language is not an expectation for us)

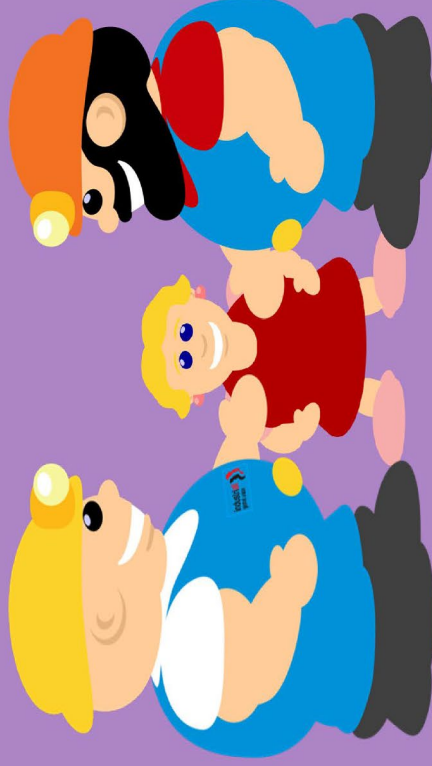
